Outstanding scientific content

The congress program features all kinds of formats and topics suitable for actuaries just starting their career as well as those who can look back on many years of professional experience.

In daily **Plenary Sessions**, top leaders from insurance, academia and regulation will discuss the future of various topics of vital importance for our industry. Where are we heading und what impact will, for example, demographic developments, new concepts of mobility and an ongoing period of low-interest rates have on the insurance industry?

Another highlight will be about 30 **Invited Speaker Sessions** covering current developments and trends in the actuarial world. Invited speaker sessions are held on each day of the ICA 2018 and are offered by all sections.
